Summary/Objective

Work with the Campus Life Director and ministry leader team to have a dynamic master plan of reaching young people through campus ministry.

Essential Functions

Develop and carry out the vision to reach every young person on middle school campuses within Gratiot or Isabella County on a weekly basis.

Ministry

Adopts the "Five Essential Characteristics of Sustainable & Fruitful Ministry Sites" (Widespread Prayer, Loving Relationships, Faithful Bible Teaching, Collaborative Community Strategy, and Adults Who Empower)

Widespread Prayer - We deliberately engage lots of Christians to intercede on behalf of the ministry site. This value needs to strategically permeate all values, areas, and actions of your daily ministry.

Loving Relationships - We consistently pursue lost kids & engage them in life-long relationships with Jesus. Campus Life uses six Relational Ministry Actions as its specialized skill set to move Loving Relationships forward: Contacting , Building Times, Appointments, Small Groups, Core Teams , Club.

Faithful Bible Teaching - We accurately handle Biblical truth, regularly coaching kids to apply it in their lives. Competent Preparation. Relevant Presentation

Collaborative Community Strategy - We intentionally work together with local churches, agencies and other partners to provide sustainable youth and family ministry.

Adults Who Empower - We strategically develop leaders to reach young people from every people group. Campus Life staff build and lead teams of Christian adults (and students) who are committed to investing in the relational ministry process with lost teens.

Job Qualifications:

A. COMPETENCIES AND SKILLS

2. Possess these people skills: Community relations ability specifically in the public school setting and able to relate well to people of all ages.
3. Possess these process skills: project planning and implementation, decision-making, problem-solving, follow-up of details, ability to ask people for help.
4. Technical knowledge: solid general understanding of the Old Testament, New Testament, Christian theology, Christian ethics, Christian living, youth culture, youth work principles, youth social issues.

1. Possess a solid growing commitment to Jesus Christ and an evangelical faith that is consistent with YFC's Statement of Faith.
2. Have a sense of "missionary calling" to the ministry of youth evangelism.
3. Be able to work with many churches
4. Be comfortable working with EVERY student group.

C. COMPATIBILITY

1. Be a self-starter and be able to get the job done under general direction rather than close supervision.
2. Be Able to operate in a flexible work situation that demands good time management and a typical work week of 10 hours and that requires some evening, weekend ministry and overnight travel.
